COOKS AND BAKERS Part of the Life Boat Crews assigned to the "Oceania." There may be 9 players assigned to this boat crew. They have a red boat and are the first crew to leave the ship if there is danger. They work as a team and try to solve the mystery. Their instructions tell them how to function as a crew.
